

PUBLICATION IN JAPANESE

An anthology of selected and translated essays from our first two meetings was published in 1996 from Shinwasha in Tokyo. This 334-page book is entitled Uta no hibiki, monogatari no yokubō: Amerika kara yomu Nihon bungaku (Echo of poems, desire for narrative: Reading Japanese literature from America) and includes 17 essays on Japanese poeticity and narrativity.
